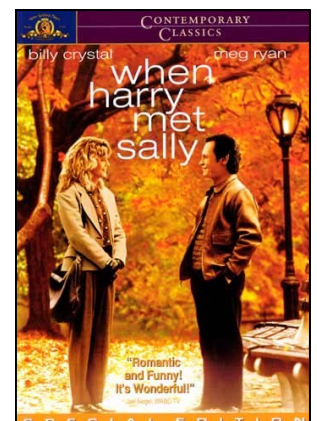
## *Eat, Pray, Love* Thursday, Jan. 13, 2011
